Medical Surveillance Physical

Asante is now offering a Medical Surveillance Physical for employees that are potentially exposed to hazardous medications.

Medical surveillance is a compilation of medical services provided by Employee Health for prevention or identification of the following-

- occupational injuries and illnesses include a review of medical and occupational history.
- physical exam.
- laboratory studies.
- biological monitoring.

A follow-up plan as needed for workers' who have shown health changes and then monitor their future health as it relates to their potential exposure to hazardous agents

Vaccinations and Respiratory Fit Testing

The following vaccines are offered to help employees become immune to infectious diseases:

- MMR
- Varicella
- TDAP
- Hepatitis B
- Flu (during flu season)

Annual Fit Testing for N-95 use includes:

- In clinic appointments.
- Department rounding.
- Train the trainer.
